To plan, teach and evaluate basketry courses. You will be part of a team of staff delivering a provision of basketry courses across a range of levels from beginner to advanced learners. As one of a few colleges offering this subject, we aim to provide access to general skills alongside more specialist workshops in a range of relevant subject areas.

KEY AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS (KPIs)

Undertake the teaching of Basketry courses specialising in weaving willow and contemporary willow.

- Teach in a flexible and creative way that reflects the programme and meets the overall requirements of the course.
- Plan, develop, revise and use teaching materials that are up to date and relevant to basketry
- Keep up to date with the subject knowledge specialism.
- Work cooperatively within the staff team and programme area.

Plan the curriculum for individual courses as required

- Take responsibility for writing the documents for courses taught including schemes of work and lesson plans.
- Take responsibility for updating relevant course documents annually and liaise with the Head of Programme over any changes.

Assess and evaluate students' learning during the class

- Assess students' learning during the course delivery.
- Give feedback to students that is informed by their performance and checked against the aims and objectives of the both the students and the course.
- Keep records of student learning which informs weekly planning and course development.
